

The Spier Hotel is situated on the historic Spier wine farm in the heart of the Stellenbosch winelands, just 20 minutes from Cape Town International

Village-style buildings, lush green lawns and spacious rooms situated next to the calming Eerste River are the defining characteristics of the Spier Hotel. The Hotel's 151 rooms are clustered around six courtyards, with each courtyard boasting its own swimming pool. The design is reminiscent of the Bo-Kaap or Mediterranean villages where pedestrians have right of way.

Explore Spier Wine Farm's fascinating history, immerse yourself in nature and encounter extraordinary art pieces on a self-guided walk, with audio guides downloadable to your smartphone, or discover the farm by cycling through the vineyards. Find locally made pieces of Africa to take home at Spier's vibrant, colourful craft market or, for the adventurers, breeze through the vineyards on a Segway.

Set foot on Cape Town's famous icon and main tourist attraction, Table Mountain. Explore the breathtaking views of the city and keep your eyes peeled for animals such as dassies, porcupines, grysbok, mongoose, snakes and tortoises, which can all be spotted on the mountain.

Dinner at the magnificent Vadas Smokehouse and Bakery on Spier Wine Farm. Expect farm-to-plate dining that embraces simple dishes and showcases the quality of produce. The restaurant overlooks the rolling lawns and ancient oaks of Spier's meticulously restored Werf.

Full Day Cape Peninsula tour - Cape Point is a spectacular sight, covered in endemic fynbos and home to breathtaking bays, beaches and rolling green hills and valleys, but an undoubted highlight of this tour is a visit to the penguins of Boulders Beach

Enjoy some shopping and dinner at The V&A Waterfront in Cape Town, an iconic destination located in the oldest working

Full Day tour of the Cape Winelands for some wine pairing experiences, as well as a picnic lunch on the lawns of historic Boschendal Estate and dinner at Eike by Bertus Basson. Eike is nestled in an old historic building in Stellenbosch and celebrates traditional South-African cooking.
